BREAKING: Mike Lindell's Real-Time Monitoring System Delivers Results During First Field Test

During Mike Lindell's August 16-17, 2023 Election Summit in Springfield, MO, he revealed his Plan to Secure Our Elections. The Plan features multiple components that work together to expose election fraud as it happens. Two components of the Plan played central roles in the pursuit of real-time monitoring. These components were the social media app, FrankSocial and the Wireless Monitoring Devices (WMD's).

In previous elections, one of the most challenging tasks faced by election fraud investigators was effectively collecting eyewitness accounts of election fraud from all across America. These accounts were disseminated in various ways, such as emails, phone calls, blog posts, text messages, and social media. There was no means of organizing and sorting this information for law enforcement – until Mike Lindell stepped in.

Mike led the effort to update his social media app, FrankSocial, to collect this information and facilitate real-time reporting of election fraud incidents by citizen investigators. He went on to create the nationwide Cause of America organization to coordinate the collection and validation of election fraud incidents. Cause of America helps to coordinate over 250,000 volunteers across all 50 states. The FrankSocial App with nearly 1 Million users was deployed in support of the 2023 election to help organize the evidence collected by these volunteers.

The WMD component of the Real-Time Monitoring System was also deployed. Data has been collected from locations across multiple states. Unexplained server access points and connections have been observed in numerous counties. Cybersecurity experts are now in the process of analyzing the data that has been collected. The results of these analyses will be shared with election officials and law enforcement officials if there are indications of any security risks and/or statutory violations.

The November 7, 2023 elections held all across America provided the first test of Mike Lindell's Real-Time Monitoring System for election. Here are the results as of 4pm Central.

There have been 203 election incidents posted.

Incidents are being reported across 18 states. This number is likely to grow as the night goes on. Only those incidents reviewed by vetted, authorized personnel with the Cause of America can be shown on the FrankSocial state feeds.

So far there have been 44 incidents reported involving machines being down.

There have been 20 incidents cited so far regarding paper ballots.

The ability to collect and organize this data is already revealing some common themes across states. Kentucky took a page from the 2020 Georgia "pipe break" incident. One of the top five most Democrat strongholds in Kentucky has been cleared out due to a supposed "gas leak". In Indiana, the Secretary of State was monitoring "power outage" issues across the state despite the lack of any severe weather. In Northampton County, Pennsylvania, voters are having their votes switched by the machines.



The bottom line is that FrankSocial is able to share substantive reports on election incidents AHEAD of the traditional media. While federal agencies such as DHS, CISA, and the Global Engagement Council are actively engaged in unconstitutional efforts to censor discussion of incidents as revealed in Congressman Jim Jordan's recent report, FrankSocial is enabling citizen journalists to report these incidents to the American people.

By any objective measure, the 2023 election test has already been an overwhelming success...and the night is young.
