SUBJECT: Criminal Complaint Against John Poulos, CEO of Dominion Voting Systems

Dear Mr. Oberlin,

During his testimony under oath on December 15, 2020 before the Michigan Senate Oversight Committee, Dominion Voting Systems CEO John Poulos is alleged to have committed 15 counts of perjury. Under Senate Rule 1.118, the Secretary of the Senate is responsible for administrative duties pertaining to the execution of Senate operations including the maintenance of the official records of Senate proceedings. The alleged false statements made by Mr. Poulos bring the integrity of these records into question. Under Senate Rule 2.102(c) "any witness, or attorney representing a witness, may be punished for contempt of the legislature" which is punishable under the provisions of MCL 4.82 and 4.83.

On behalf of the Michigan Grassroots Alliance, I would thereby like to formally request that the Secretary of the Senate initiate an investigation in cooperation with the Senate Sergeant at Arms into the veracity of the statements made by Mr. Poulos during his Senate testimony. Should the results of the investigation merit such actions, I request that the Sergeant at Arms issue formal indictments against Mr. Poulos for his attempts to deceive the citizens of Michigan.

In support of this request, I have enclosed a 51-page report that cites the alleged false statement made by Mr. Poulos, an explanation of the truth regarding his statement, an explanation of why his false statement was materially false and the evidence that supports these assertions.
